Giant salvinia is a highly invasive aquatic fern from South America easily spread to other lakes by boats, trailers and personal watercraft. Expanding populations of giant salvinia on Toledo Bend now threaten the fisheries in Sam Rayburn and other water bodies in East Texas.

HELP PROTECT YOUR NATURAL RESOURCES

All boaters on Toledo Bend are asked to help prevent any further spread of giant salvinia by cleaning all aquatic vegetation from boat motors and trailers before leaving launch areas.
